## Schedule of DLC families recorded in the 1836 census of the Commune of St Pierre-lès-Calais, Pas-de-Calais, France

The census (French: recensement) record document designated M3856 is held and conserved by the Pas-de-Calais France archives department. It is available to view on the Calais Archives website <http://www.archivespasdecalais.fr/Archives-en-ligne>

The page number (of 131) shown refers to the online census record.

The 1848 Migration heading indicates whether or not the person migrated to the Australian Colonies in 1848.

Section A begins on page 2; Section B begins on page 16; Section C begins on page 23; Section D begins on page 33; Section E begins on page 60; Section F begins on page 62; Section G begins on page 88. Streets are not recorded in this census record.

The census record dated 25 May 1836 notes 7603 people living in the Commune of St Pierre-lès-Calais.
