Schedule of DLC family names recorded in the 1851 census of the Commune of St Pierre-lès-Calais, Pas-de-Calais, France

The census (French: recensement) record document designated M3960 is held and conserved by the Pas-de-Calais France archives department. It is available to view on the Calais Archives website <http://www.archivespasdecalais.fr/Archives-en-ligne>

The names shown in **bold** are those of lacemaker families that travelled to the Australian colonies in 1848 and the few years after. They may or may NOT be related to those families. Any known relationship is shown in the 1848 Migration heading. There may be other Lacemakers of Calais names in the Calais census.

The page number (of 382) shown refers to the online digital census record.

The digital census record dated 15 April 1851 notes 11325 people living in the Commune of St Pierre-lès-Calais.

The word in the [square brackets] is as written in the census.
